

Nebraska Law Enforcement

Hall of Fame (POAN)

PURPOSE:

To recognize the accomplishments and deeds of individual law enforcement officers.

REQUIREMENTS:

To be nominated for the Hall of Fame Award the person must:

1. Have been killed in the line of duty; or
2. Be regularly or medically retired and contributed significantly to law enforcement and/or to the organization. (regular retirement shall mean meeting the minimum requirements and drawing from a pension fund)
3. Be an active law enforcement officer and contributed greatly to law enforcement and/or to the organization; or
4. Be or have been a regular full or retired member, except in the case of death.

NOMINATIONS:

May be made by any regular member of the organization and shall include at least the following information:

1. Name and address of nominee
2. Department or Agency
3. Position/current or past
4. Narrative of action(s) or contribution(s) to law enforcement or organization
5. Person submitting
6. Others supporting the nomination

SELECTION:

The selection from those nominated will be done by the "Hall of Fame: selection committee appointed yearly by the organization's President. The committee will consist of at least 3 members and no more than 5. One of those appointed will be designated as the Chairperson.

The award will be presented at the organization's annual conference.
