Raise the standards of Law Enforcement and the personnel connected therewith.

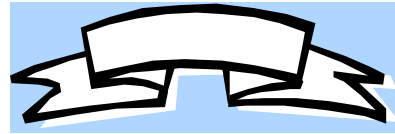
Provide continuing education and training for Law Enforcement.

Associate Full Member:

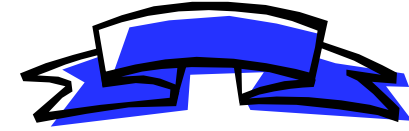
Any full-time non-commissioned employee of any police department in any Nebraska municipality or part-time police officers.
